Session 1 *Drama Kids Playhouse - Superhero Adventures* **Full Day** 9 am – 4:00 pm

Session 3 *Printmaking* **Full Day** 9 am – 4:00 pm

The art of printmaking is often forgotten, but practiced for thousands of years. As time goes on, we've developed and learned modern versions of these methods. We will be learning about the world's modern printmakers and how they manipulate materials to make prints. Campers will experience new materials and approaches Screen Printing, Relief, Collagraph, and Monotype/Monoprints. At the end of the week we will all have portfolios of editions and matrixes to take home, as well as many experiences and experiments.

Session 4 *LEGO WeDo* **Full Day** 9 am – 4:00 pm

New! LEGO Robotics *WeDo 2.0* teaches kids programming skills while making science come to life! The newly designed software and LEGO building kits allows kids to make untethered, free-roaming robots capable of completing structured and open ended tasks. Build roaming bots that use sensors to know when to stop or create a shake table to test house designs to withstand an earthquake. Explore fun new programming options with *WeDo 2.0* and take home your own new minifigure.

Session 5 *Vet School* **Morning session** (9-1:00)

Do you dream of becoming a veterinarian? Grab your lab coat, animal lovers, as we learn about our favorite furry, flying and fishy friends! Make amazing animal models, build big bones, and investigate animal intestines from our favorite vertebrates: birds, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and fish. End the week with a featured visit with a live animal.

Session 5 *Wicked Wacky Lab* **Afternoon Session** (1:00-4)

Spend a wild wacky week at the Wicked Cool Lab. Grow enormous polymer cubes and create your own super stretchy formulas from chemical concoctions. Analyze mysterious liquids with kitchen chemistry and make all kinds of slime! Cultivate colorful crystals and go out with a bang as you experiment with chemical reactions.

Session 7 *Animatronics: Build Your Own Robo-Puppet*

Full Day 9 am – 4:00 pm

Design, build and program a motion activated robotic hand! Students in this workshop learn practical robotics skills by building an animatronic puppet hand. Once the felt puppet is made, students use servo motors to control the puppet's hand. This is a motion activated, cellphone controlled robotic hand capable of grabbing objects. Students will leave the class with an understanding of how puppets can come to life.

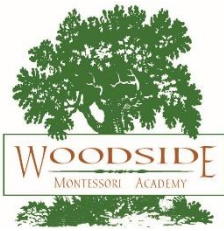
Session 8 *Intro to 3D Printing Design*

Full Day Program 9 am – 4:00 pm

Students will learn the basics of computer-aided design using 3D modeling software Sketchup. The course covers basic design principles and creation techniques — everything you need to get started designing your own 3D creations! All programming will be available in an online repository for easy home access. The parts designed in class will be turned into reality using our 3D printer. Students will develop their own Mouse Trap Car in this course.

Cancellations, Withdrawals and Refunds
