Session 1 *Sports Mania!*

In this fun-filled week campers will enjoy playing and learning about various sports. This camp will provide exciting and interesting activities while also engaging in physical activities. Campers will explore many different sports, such as, frisbee, soccer, etc. while also exploring the sport's history.

Session 2 *The Sewing Bees....*

Learning to sew is fun! This will be a beginner class - no experience necessary! We will start from the beginning with both hand sewing and machine sewing. Sewing has a built-in benefit of helping to increase focus, building eye hand coordination as well as strengthening the pincer grip - in addition to the satisfaction of making something you can actually use! It is time to let our creativity pour out!

They will have some choices in what projects they choose to make. The choices will include a reading pillow, a library book bag, a planket (a pillow with a blanket inside) a stuffed creature and a pair of pajama bottoms.

We will learn about how fabric is made and how different cultures embellish their fabric. When not at a sewing machine, the children will create their own fabric and projects using fabric pens, paint and embroidery including creating our self-portrait!

Session 3 *Maker Mania*

Come explore ways children can use STEM to design, craft, and build different projects. Each day we will work to create a different project. We will be exploring Cricut, 3-D Printing, and Woodworking. Projects will include creating a coffee mug with Cricut, making a t-shirt, 3-D Printing Name signs, creating a rainbow coat rack, and building a birdhouse.

Note: Due to Printing Times 3-D printing projects may need to be picked up after the week of camp.

Session 4 *History of Flight & Drones*

Come fly with us. We will be exploring the history of flight throughout time as we build different types of gliders, wing designs, and water rockets each morning and in the afternoon we will be taking to the skies as drone commanders. Children will learn how to make a flight plan, program the Ryze Tello drone, and let it fly.

Session 5 *Lego Robotics Club Part 1*

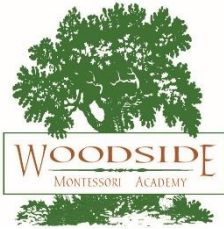
Come join us for an introduction into Lego robotics through the Lego Wedo 2 Kit. Children will learn to build different robot designs and learn to integrate tilt and distance sensors. Incorporated into their designs are wheels and axles and gears. Each day the children will build a different robot where the coding and build gets progressively harder.

Session 6 *Lego Robotics Club Part 2*

For children that have already dipped their toes into Lego Robotics. The children will use the new Lego Spike Prime robots to explore more complex building problems. They will be challenged to build robots and different attachments to compete in an abbreviated FLL Lego Challenge using last season's 2021 Cargo Connect Challenge Board.

Session 7 *Nature Adventures*

This week is designed for kids who would rather be outdoors than in and can't get enough of plants and animals. This week will give students a chance to step into nature and embrace it! With on and off-campus expeditions and guest presenters, we will explore the world around us, have adventures in our own backyard, and learn about the world around us. In the afternoons we will be exploring five different math in nature topics: math in outer space, the Fibonacci sequence, hexagons, fractals, and concentric circles.

- ❖ Withdrawal after the Monday before the first day of your child's first session will result in forfeit of the entire tuition amount. **(Staff is hired in advance based on enrollment.)** Requests for withdrawal for serious medical reasons once a session has started must be submitted in writing with a note from the child's physician. Refunds are made on a pro-rated basis.
