Session 1 *Krazy Knex Return to the Carnival*

Come join us as the children explore the world of knex. This awesome STEM material allows children to explore different physics concepts. Each day will be spent learning about how simple machines work and how different structures are created in a way to provide the most amount of strength in certain situations. Children will have opportunities to build the Golden Gate Bridge. This will culminate with children building large scale models of different carnival rides such as a giant Ferris wheel, working rollercoasters, and other exciting thrill rides.

Session 2 *The Sewing Bees....*



Learning to sew is fun- but sewing with friends is even better! This is a beginner class- no experience necessary. While sewing can be relaxing, it is also an indispensable skill that can last a lifetime. In addition to making something that you can use, sewing helps increase focus, helps build eye hand coordination as well as strengthening the pincer grip. The children will also spend part of the time learning to operate a sewing machine safely as well as time doing handwork projects.

The projects that will be available to make during this camp are, a sleep mask, a quilted water bottle holder, a zippered pouch to keep their treasures safe, an animal shaped pillow or an “ugly doll “ that they can design and bring to life with scraps, buttons and stuffing!

Session 3 *Explorations in ART*

Let your creativity and ingenuity guide you as you recreate classic and modern art styles and create art that is unique to you. We will explore the elements of art and how different artists used them. Participants will have the opportunity to use a variety of mediums. Make your imagination come to life through art making. Let's create together this Summer!

Session 4 *Maker Mania Match 2*

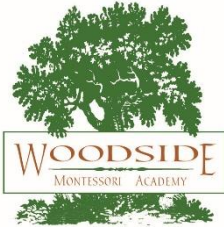
In Maker Mania Match 2 children will learn how to use several different types of technologies and tools to create exciting new projects. Children will learn how to create various 2-D Steam projects using Cricut Design software. They will have the opportunity to use both Cricut Maker to create t-shirts and mugs and an Ortur laser CNC to create a custom cutting board, design their own bookmarks and create their own 3-D model of their favorite movie character. In the afternoons children will dive into 3-D printing using tinkercad and flash print to make their own projects on Our Flashforge printers.

Session 5 *Drone Pilots Assemble*

Be ready to take to the skies as children become drone pilots, mission commanders, and flight planners. Children will spend the day learning how to code different types of robots using block coding. Each day will introduce a new type of robot such as Photon, Kibo, Ozobot, Botley, and the Colbie Coding mouse. No previous coding experience needed. In the afternoons children will take to the skies to pilot TELLO drones through different obstacles.

Session 6 *Lego Maniacs Needed*

Children will have the opportunity to combine two awesome skills in one this week: Legos and Coding! Children will learn how to use either the Lego WeDo or the Lego Spike systems to explore different builds and different types of coding. Children will learn to incorporate sensors into their builds. At the end of the week children will get the opportunity to explore a First Lego Competition board and modify their robots to complete one of the missions that our own Woodside Lego Eaters competed on this past fall. This camp is designed for children that are both new to Lego robotics or have some prior experience.

- ❖ Withdrawal after the Monday before the first day of your child's first session will result in forfeit of the entire tuition amount. **(Staff is hired in advance based on enrollment.)** Requests for withdrawal for serious medical reasons once a session has started must be submitted in writing with a note from the child's physician. Refunds are made on a pro-rated basis.
