Session 6 *Wicked Cool Vet School*

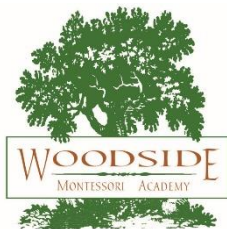

Tuition

- ❖ The non-refundable \$50 deposit (per child/per session) is due at the time of registration.
- ❖ **Full tuition is due** one week before the start of the first session – **July 1, 2025**
- ❖ Discounts:
 1. The sibling discount is 10%.
 2. If you register for 4 weeks, a 10% discount will be applied.****ONLY one discount will be applied**

Cancellations, Withdrawals and Refunds

- ❖ All cancellations and withdrawals must be made in writing.
- ❖ Cancellation for any reason prior to the Monday before the first day of your child's first session will result in a full refund less the nonrefundable deposit of \$50 per child per session.
- ❖ Withdrawal after the Monday before the first day of your child's first session will result in forfeit of the entire tuition amount. (**Staff are hired in advance based on enrollment.**) Requests for withdrawal for serious medical reasons once a session has started must be submitted in writing with a note from the child's physician. Refunds are made on a pro-rated basis.
